“Gutters are nothing but trouble.

They clog up and you have to constantly clean them. And here in the south, it's so humid that water gets behind the gutters and rots your fascia board.

“Drops fall in a soft spray.”

My first home had no gutters. After it rained, there was a trench six inches deep under the eaves. I put up Rainhandlers, filled the trench, and you'd never know there had been an erosion problem. You don't have that big stream of water pouring off the roof — Rainhandlers break the water into drops that fall away from the house like a soft spray, so gently they don't harm your lawn or flowerbeds.

I just ordered Rainhandlers to put on my father's house. He's 83 and can't clean gutters any more. I'm getting close to retirement myself and built a new home as maintenance-free as possible. I installed Rainhandlers in one day. FedEx bought me the package and that evening they were on. They're simple and they work. I had to buy adapters because my fascia board isn't perpendicular to the ground. Rainhandler sells the adapters and extenders I needed and they worked great.

Once you put the brackets up, the louvers just snap in and out. Everything's aluminum and they're easy to put up. I'm getting ready to order more Rainhandlers to put on my new garage.
